


Promoting Fire Ecology Research, Education, and Management

### **CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS**

AFE now offers two Certification Programs: a Wildland Fire Professional Certification for fire ecologists, managers, and technicians and a Wildland Fire Academic Program Certification to recognize academic programs which prepare future fire professionals. The complexity and importance of fire science and management is increasing worldwide. Our overarching goal is to support fire ecology and ecologically-based fire management while advancing fire science and its application. AFE's Regional Conferences and International Fire Congresses draw some of the top fire researchers, managers, and policymakers in the U.S. and from around the world to share their discoveries, experiences, and initiatives in fire ecology. AFE's Fire Congresses are among the largest gatherings of fire scientists in the world, bringing together hundreds of participants from dozens of countries across six continents. These events provide opportunities for learning, networking, collaborating, and socializing with colleagues from other agencies, universities, regions, and nations. At our Fire Congresses, AFE presents the Herbert Stoddard, Harold Biswell, and Henry Wright lifetime achievement awards to people who have made significant contributions to fire ecology and management in the U.S.





## HISTORY

AFE began as a small group of researchers and managers in California during the late 1990's, and then incorporated as a tax-exempt nonprofit organization in 2001. AFE has grown to become the leading international scientific and educational society for fire ecologists and managers. AFE continues to grow through its regional fire ecology conferences, and especially its International Fire Ecology and Management Congresses. Held every three years, the "Fire Congress" brings together agency and academic scientists, educators, students, managers, practitioners, and policymakers from all over the world to network and learn the latest in fire ecology research and management. AFE has expanded its international reach through its peerreviewed journal, Fire Ecology, and through its website, www.fireecology.net, which both feature cutting edge science and the most innovative ecological thinking in fire management.
