 - Pass Pack Test at Arduous Level
 - Sign up for 1 of 5 live fire classes offered
 - O Proper PPE
 - Uniform shirt
- O Most 2nd year but some 1st year = "Crew Foremen"

<u>Suppression Duties</u>


- O DNR agreement to offer suppression assistance
- Adams/Friendship Ranger station
- Other opportunities
 - O Wontor Fire April 8th 2012
 - O Silver Creek Fire late Sept. thru early October

Contract Burns, etc. Emphasis on Student Preparedness/Safety

- O Spring 2012
 - O 23 landowners totaling 389 acres
 - O Assisted WI DNR on 5 burns totaling 446 acres
 - 1 herbicide application and 1 grass planting (54 acre WSG installation)
- O Spring 2013
 - O 32 landowners signed up to burn totaling 855.5 acres (As of January 28th 2013)
 - O Assist WI DNR, acres?
- O Other work?
 - O Grass plantings
 - O Brush/Invasive control
 - Small area herbicide applications (target species)
